Take Time To Remember!

Top Priority!

Are you sure you have remembered to do everything you meant to do today?

Is there something you know you should do – but you keep putting it off?

Many people are like this about getting right with God. You know that it is something that you should deal with, but maybe you don't know how, or you get uncomfortable thinking about it.

What if getting right with God was like getting a summons for Court, or being asked to fill in a tax return? Most of us would realise that we no longer had a choice; we would have to deal with it.

This is the way that the Bible tells us God looks at this issue. We don't really have a choice – getting right with God needs to come to the top of our 'to-do' list!

Leave God Out of My Life!

You can live your life without God if you want to – He has given you that freedom. But if you choose to live your life ignoring God you cannot expect to spend eternity with Him.

The Bible tells us that while God is patient He will not wait for us for ever. The Lord Jesus told of a day when it will be too late to get right with God. A time when He will say “Depart from Me, all you workers of iniquity” Luke's Gospel Ch.13 v 27.

That word 'iniquity' or 'sin' is one that sticks in many people's throats, but it is at the root of why you need to get right with God. Why you need to make this a priority.

But if you're honest you don't need a leaflet to come through your door to tell you that you have sinned against God. The question is: are you going to do anything about it?

Just Give Me A Chance!

When we speak about 'getting right with God' most people assume that the answer is to 'turn over a new leaf' or to 'get religion'. Would it surprise you to learn that God's Word, the Bible, says exactly the opposite?

In Isaiah Ch. 64 v 5-6 we read: God is “indeed angry, for we have sinned ... and we need to be saved. But we are all like an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags”

Did you get that? Our good deeds; our righteous acts; the very best that we can do: are like filthy rags in the sight of a Holy God!

This is fundamental. There is nothing that we can do to make ourselves more acceptable to God. No wonder Isaiah says that 'we need to be saved'.
